

Mercury Products Recycling Program

Fluorescent bulbs and tubes contain mercury

Fluorescent bulbs and tubes are a great way to save energy. They use three-quarter less energy than incandescent lamps and are safe to use but contain mercury. Mercury is a toxic substance and it is especially harmful to children and pregnant women. If fluorescents are disposed improperly or broken, mercury may be released into the environment, posing a health hazard.

Please bring the following to the City of Clinton Public Works & Utilities Department to be recycled:

- Mercury thermostats
- Fluorescent tubes
- Compact fluorescent light bulbs (CFLs)
- Universal waste lamps including, but not limited to...
 - * Fluorescent
 - * High intensity discharge
 - * Mercury vapor
