

MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING HELD FEBRUARY 21, 2006

A special meeting of the City Council of the City of Clinton, North Carolina was held at 7:00 p.m. on February 21, 2006 at City Hall Auditorium. Mayor Starling presided. Councilmembers Becton, Harris, Stefanovich, Strickland and Turlington were present. The city attorney, city clerk, city manager, planning director and planner public were in attendance.

ANNEXATION

Mayor Starling opened a public hearing on the question of annexation.

John Connet said the city is required to have an information meeting and a public hearing before council can consider adopting annexations ordinances. He said the information meeting was held January 24, 2006 and this is the public hearing. John told of materials that were sent to property owners in the proposed annexation areas as a result of council's questions at the January 24 meeting.

Jeff Vreugdenhil reviewed the annexation schedule. He said annexation ordinances will be on the agenda of the April 4, 2006 council meeting for council to consider.

Cynthia Wallace said she did not have questions, but she was here to listen.

Mayor Starling said he is still against the annexation.

Gus Sutton said he was opposed to the annexation.

No one else wished to be heard, and the hearing was closed.

Councilmember Stefanovich made a motion at 8:08 p.m. to continue the meeting until 8:00 a.m. on February 24, 2006. Councilmember Turlington seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.
