



Program Withdraw, Refund & Transfer Policy

- Class fees are 100% refundable when the class is cancelled by the Recreation Department. Anyone withdrawing from a class that has not been cancelled by the Clinton Recreation & Parks Department must request a refund, in writing, at least ten (10) business days in advance of the scheduled start of the class.
- Anyone who is withdrawing from an athletic program must request a refund, in writing, at least ten (10) business days in advance of rosters created.
- Request to transfer to a future program date/session must be made at least (10) business days prior to the start date; transfers will not be made if less than the (10) business day period. No refunds, credits or transfers will be issued after a program has started or concluded.

***Any child that signs up to play recreation athletics. It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to inform CRPD staff if they will no longer be participating.**

- Account credits do not expire and may be used for anything within CRPD towards registration fees. If a child ages out of our programs with a pre-existing credit, additional credits will be mailed in the form of a check to address provided.
