



# Check List

- Leaking, overflowing, or outdated septic tank
- Vehicles that leak oil, antifreeze, transmission, or brake fluid
- Large paved areas of impervious surfaces that rain directly to streets or storm drains
- Bare, unplanted areas from which soil erodes when it rains
- Downspouts or drain pipes that empty water into the street of storm drain system
- Yard clippings, fertilizer, or pesticides left in streets or sidewalks
- Hose used to clean driveway
- Over watering of gardens or lawns
- Pet or animal waste left in the street, sidewalks, or on the ground
- Improper storage and disposal of pesticides, gasoline, oil, paint, etc.
- Storm drain used to dispose if yard waste or chemicals
- Lawns or gardens not fertilized deeply enough or over fertilized
- Lack of landscaping that would allow water to infiltrate into the soil
- Pouring grease into the sink drain or toilet
