
Clinton Police Department Press Release

Clinton Police Department responded to Sampson Regional Medical Center on May 11, 2017, at approximately 6:52 pm in reference to a cutting victim. Uniform officers learned that Ebony Moore, 20 of Fanny Johnson Lane, Warsaw had been cut multiple times while at Dogwood Circle. She had been driven to Sampson Regional by a friend. Initially the physical address where the incident occurred was unknown, but officers were able to determine that it occurred at 206 Dogwood Circle. The suspect in the incident had already left Dogwood Circle. The Clinton Police Neighborhood Improvement Team was called and began investigating the cutting.

Preliminary information indicated that the cutting occurred during an altercation between two females while at 206 Dogwood Circle. This incident was the result of an ongoing dispute between the two. Mrs. Moore had several lacerations on her body, to include her stomach, neck, and back. She was treated at Sampson Regional for serious but non-life threatening injuries. The second female was identified as Jessica McLamb, 26, from Eastover Avenue, Clinton.

While officers were investigating the incident, Mrs. McLamb arrived at the magistrate's office to turn herself in. Investigators met with Mrs. McLamb and subsequently charged her with Assault with a Deadly Weapon with Intent to Kill Inflicting Serious Injury. She was placed under a \$200,000 secured bond and is scheduled to appear in court on May 19, 2017.
